I have been meaning to get this letter of recommendation to you earlier. I never seem to have enough time during the day. However, with the holidays fast approaching, I certainly wanted to thank you for everything you were able to do in the adjustment of our fire loss with Fireman's Fund.

When the fire occurred to my 12,000 square foot warehouse, I assumed that my broker would be able to assist me in this matter.
