Dear Bill:

Enough time has passed for the magnitude of your services to have finally “settled in”, and I want to take time to thank you for what you did for us.

As you know, Catahoula Parish School District receives local support completely from sales and property taxes. We are mostly rural without benefit of any large urban area or commercial basis for revenue. With a declining population base, we are therefore faced with aging buildings, shrinking enrollments, increased costs, and declining revenues.

One of our “mothballed” (to put it kindly) high school facilities suffered some structural roof damage as a result of a small tornado. That facility was roofed and sided with a cement asbestos material. You were able to convince the insurance company to pay for abatement of the entire problem and pay for complete interior repairs to a magnitude not envisioned by our staff. The abatement and the actual cash value of those repairs left us with a windfall of a very considerable sum of money – for our discretionary use.
